

Minutes of the Elk Run Cemetery Meeting
September 8, 1883

At a meeting of the trustees of Elk Run Cemetery the following were present: Miller, Kite, Hammer, Kite, Sanford, and the following business transacted. The secretary showed in his report a balance of \$29.30 belonging to the cemetery fund which was ordered to be disposed of as follows: 1st- pay an account due W E Kite for making gates \$6.00; retain in hands of secretary \$15.00 to pay for having the cemetery cleaned off and for recording deeds when made and if any funds remained to pay it over to H A Kite who was authorized to purchase locusts and saw same into proper size for the purpose of showing corners and numbering lots in cemetery. It was also ordered that the secretary execute a bond (if required) to H A Kite for any balance due him on the cemetery lot, in the name of the trustees of Elk Run Cemetery, as soon as the SR. H A Kite and wife presented to the secretary a general warrented deed.

A resolution was offered by T K Miller to fix upon a compensation for the secretary, but so resolution was not adopted. Meeting then adjourned.
