

Minutes of the Meeting of the Elk Run Cemetery  
January 12, 1891

At a meeting of the trustees held at Bear Palmers store, present: H A Kite, M C Long, and A C Bear. The meeting was called to order by H A Kite and proceeded to business. On reference to the books, it was found that Elk Run old fellows lodge #54 was in debt to trustees to the amount of \$29.87 but in order to bring or settle the matter and close it up, the said trustees agreed to allow the bill by said lodge for fuel and lights of \$13.39 which leaves a balance of \$16.48 due the trustees on rent for hall.

It was also ordered that the names of R W Bear, F Ruckert and John Cover be entered on the book. It was also ordered that the Secretary pay W C Long \$10.00 for work done on cemetery in November of 1890. By order on R W Bear, H A Kite, the \$10.00 from F Ruckert for lot deducting \$1.30 for plank and nails, which left \$8.70 paid A C Bear. On motion the meeting adjourned.

Mr H A Kite received \$10 from Alexander Hanney, all of which was turned over to the secretary. It was ordered by said trustees that we purchase a stove for the use of the hall over the schoolhouse at Elk Run. Also a lot , chairs and benches for same. It was also ordered that the secretary see Roth Hanes and see how much money is in his hands belonging to said hall.
