

Minutes of the Meeting of the Elk Run Cemetery  
Aug 20, 1904

At a meeting of the directors held at the cemetery, present: H A Kite, B F Coffman, W C Long, & M M Jarman. The minutes of the last meeting were read. The directors looked over the grounds. A bill of W C Long for buying and setting stakes, etc was presented amounting to \$6.40 and ordered paid. The question of painting and numbering stakes was brought up and it was decided that W E Kite see W B Hensley and have it done as agreed upon at the last meeting. On motion W C Long was authorized and directed to have the cemetery cleaned up as near as possible in accordance with the rules, on the best terms possible. The bill to be paid by the treasurer on said Longs order. On motion W C Long agreed to clean up the old grave yard for the sum of ten dollars in accordance with an agreement as follows. Private contract with W C Long for cleaning up old cemetery Aug 20, 1904. W C Long agrees to clean up the old cemetery for ten dollars. Grind all the oak, hickory, sassafras, and mow off all the small under growth such as briars, brushes, weeds and everything unsightly and unfit to be in a grave yard. It is fully understood and agreed that he is to use all the care possible to protect the sod and flowers on the graves which have been kept in order or attended to by the friends of persons buried there.
