At a meeting of the board of directors of ERC, present: B F Coffman, W C Long, W E Kite, E L Taliaferro, & M M Jarman. Rev M Cupp made a statement in reference to the old ER Church property, with the view of using it for the benefit of the community by turning it over to this board for the use of ERC. On motion Rev. Cupp was requested to get up a petition asking the court to convey or turn over to this board full control of the ER Church grounds for burial purposes, we the trustees agree to grant the MB Church the use of the grave for two years for camp meeting purposes. On motion made adjournment.

Minutes of the Elk Run Cemetery Meeting
Oct 17, 1908

At a meeting of the board of directors of ERC, present: BF Coffman, WC Long, EL Taliaferro, WE Kite & M M Jarman. On motion of Mr Long, seconded by Mr Taliaferro the board passed an order advancing the price of lots. First choice to be sold for \$20.00 each, second choice \$15.00, and third choice \$10.00 each. The difference to be designated by the board. On motion W C Long was authorized to consult a lawyer and take the proper steps to have ER Church property taken into cemetery. On motion after looking over the ground it was decided that all lots lying north east of the avenue in front of the vault of J R Cover are to be sold hereafter for not less than twenty dollars each except those South of the walk way running by the lot of Phillip Kagey & N & E of the Avenue running along the East boundary of the said Kagey lot which shall be sold for not less than ten dollars each the lots West of the Avenue on which the Cover vault is located to the next Avenue on the West shall be sold for not less than fifteen dollars each. No other business appearing the board adjourned.
