

Minutes of the Elk Run Cemetery Meeting

May 7, 1935

The board of trustees of the Elk Run Cemetery met at the Bank of Elkton, May the 7th of 1935. The meeting was called to order by the president. E. B. Coffman the following members were present: E. B. Coffman, J. G. Harnsberger, C. E. Miller, Hue Frey, W. E. Kite, and C. H. J. Blose. The minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved, a motion was then made second and carried that Mr. T. H. Cave be retained as superintendant for the rest of the year 1936 and to look after the cemetery as before and keep the time of the man to be hired to do the work. And lay off graves and soforth, for the consideration of thirty dollars and use of the house and garden.

Moved second and carried that Mr. Hue Frey hire a man at 15 cents per hour as necessary to do the work to keep the yard in order. This man is expected to dig graves and clean after burial amount collect for same at the usual price.

May 10, 1935

The trustees of the Elk Run Cemetery met at the cemetery. The following members present: E. B. Coffman, J. G. Harnsberger, Hue Frey, T. H. Cave, and C. H. J. Blose. Mr. T. H. Cave refused to continue to superintend the cemetery and it was arranged that E. B. Coffman and Hue Frey should get up a contract and hire a man to care for the cemetery as per contract.
