

The meeting opened at 7:35 P.M. with VP Flick presiding.

V.P. Flick stated that the meeting had been called to make the members acquainted with the present status of the Corporation. Since no guidelines have been laid down by the Town it was felt that not much in the way of constructive action could be taken. The minutes of our last meeting were read and it was agreed that the wishes of the Board, as stated at that meeting had been carried out. The Town of Elkton is now the owner of the Cemetery corporation and and financial reports had been taken over as of November 1984.

Flick reported that there was a strong possibility that Mr. Richard Monger would accept the Presidency of the Commission if asked by the Mayor. All present were in favor of asking Mr. Monger and it is known that Mr. Hensley and Mr. Schumacher this action. V.P. Flick is to notify the Town officials of the feeling of the Commission in this matter.
