


Re: Elk Run Cemetery, Salary for Mowing & Weeding & maintenance.

I received A phone call from Donald Merica regarding the complete maintenance of our cemetery. Mr merica is receiving A total of \$ 137,00 per week for all mowing and weeding, and feel,s this is inadiaquate for this amount of work. We have increased the physical size of our cemetary by over 3 acres.

After discussing this problem with all eight member,s of the commission, it was felt the least that we could do was to pay A mininum wage of \$5.15 per hour, which should raise his salery to A livable wage, depending on the hour,s of work. Upon your approval we will try this for the remainder of 2003, and reveiw this again earley in 2004.

Should this not meet with your approval, we can discuss this when I return from Montana sometime earley in october.
