#### JOB DESCRIPTION

### JOB TITLE: LABORER – ENTRY LEVEL

# **Responsibilities and Duties:**

Performs manual labor including, but not limited to, mowing and trimming grass, cutting brush, trimming shrubs, water flowers, weeding planting beds, cleaning ditches, picking up litter and debris from streets and public rights of way, sweeping floors, cleaning walls, setting up and breaking down for public events, and moving furniture and boxes. Also, assists in maintenance and repair of streets, curbs, gutters, and sidewalks and bulk pick-up collection. May operate light or heavy equipment in performing tasks associated with maintenance and construction of the town or utility work for water and sewer system maintenance. Uses hand and garden tools such as rakes, shovels, powered week eaters, push and riding mowers.

Work could involve exposure to uncomfortable working conditions and moving equipment.

Must be available day, evenings, weekends and holidays.

Work is performed under the general direction of the Director of Public Works or Crew Leader as assigned by the Director of Public Works.

# **Requirements:**

Must be able to exert up to 100 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 50 pounds frequently and up to 25 pounds constantly lifting, carrying, pushing, pulling or otherwise moving objects.

Must have the ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

Must have the ability to keep records and reports on hours worked and materials used.

Must have knowledge of the operation and maintenance of any light or heavy equipment used by the Town of Elkton.
